The Office is authorized \$50,937,260 in FY16 and \$50,991,804 in FY17, including workers' compensation claims costs, subject to final determination of the Board of Directors.

Market average is above the authorized GAA amounts for the Executive Director and market analysis is not currently employed. The Board of Directors determines the Executive Director's compensation. The Executive Director determines the Deputy Director's salary based on qualifications, duties, and performance.
