

From our speaker, Ashley Hamilton: I've been a firefighter for 13 years, 9 years with the city of Austin. Last year I was awarded firefighter of the year. The firefighters and I created an interactive digital map that helps us navigate to stairwells, elevators, alarm control panels in emergencies. In the world of first responders, we have 300 seconds to make critical decisions where the consequence of failure is death or catastrophic loss. The tool we created helps us saves lives and reduce property loss. Emergency Planning empowers the troops on the ground information they need to make better decisions. Because in our world, every second matters.
