

Alex Abdun-Nabi is currently the Program Manager Emergency Preparedness for CapMetro, the transit system for the Austin, Texas region. In his current role, Abdun-Nabi is responsible for emergency planning, continuity of operations planning training, exercise, and response for the system, leading the agency's response to Winter Storms Uri, Landon, and Mara.
