For the past twenty years, Daniel has worked extensively to provide cybersecurity expertise in a variety of industries from non-profits, State Government, and City Government. Work pertaining to cybersecurity has been performed at a variety of levels. One of the first large-scale efforts initiated by Daniel was to hold personnel training on the dangers and management of email communications in a secure manner, to staff in a mid-size non-profit organization. Daniel has evaluated and implemented a variety of security controls in medium to large organizations, impacting as many as 50,000 users. Each of these environments required compliance with a host of regulatory entities, such as the finance industry (Sarbanes-Oxley), health industry (HIPPA), electric utilities (North American Electric Reliability Corporation), and Texas state mandates. Daniel has provided operational support for a variety of technologies, including email platforms, Data Loss Prevention controls, incident response monitoring, alerting, and event resolution, along with network security appliances.
